

## A+D 2008 Transfer Guidelines for the Admissions Process for the Art History Program (FAA)

In addition to the general School of Art+Design transfer admission requirements, art history applicants follow these guidelines.

**Transfer applications must be postmarked by March 1, 2008.**

---

**To apply for admission to the Art History Program in the College of Fine and Applied Arts, students must submit the following:**

1) Writing Sample

The Writing Sample should be at least three pages in length and may be a paper written for a class.

2) Statement of Interest

The Statement of Interest should be approximately 250 words in length and explain why you want to major in Art History. It does not have to include specific career goals (*although it may*). You might speak of your intellectual interests, your interest in art, the areas of art history that most intrigue you, or the general skills and abilities you hope to acquire.
